RESEARCH AND FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT TRAINING:

The East African Consortium for Clinical Research (EACCR) through the Kilimanjaro Clinical Research Institute (EACCR Training node) is inviting applicants for a short training course on Research and Financial Management that will be held on 9th to 13th April 2018 in Moshi, Tanzania.

The East African Consortium for Clinical Research (EACCR) is a capacity building Network comprising of 23 institutions from 6 countries in East Africa (that include: - Uganda, Kenya, Tanzania, Rwanda, Sudan and Ethiopia in collaboration with 6 Northern partners) and 8 northern partner institutions from 6 northern countries and is funded by the European & Developing Countries Clinical Trials Partnership (EDCTP). The network was established in 2009 with EACCR1 and had their award renewed in December 2016 as EACCR2. The EACCR2 consortium has its secretariat at the Uganda Virus Research Institute (UVRI) in Entebbe. EACCR consists of five Nodes such as HIV node headed by UVRI in Uganda, Malaria Node headed by KEMRI-Wellcome trust Kilifi in Kenya, Neglected Tropical diseases Node headed by the Institute of Endemic Diseases (IEND) in Sudan, TB node headed by NIMR-Muhimbili in Tanzania and the Training node headed by KCRI-KCMC in Moshi Tanzania.

1. Applicants must be Financial Managers and/or Grant Administrators
2. Research Investigators
3. Applicants should be from institutions affiliated with EACCR
4. Applicants must clearly indicate how they will apply the knowledge and skills
