### INTERNATIONAL MASTER IN VACCINOLOGY TRAINING OPPORTUNITY

The East African Consortium for Clinical Research (EACCR) in collaboration with the University of Lausanne, Switzerland and Lausanne University Hospital (CHUV) is offering training opportunities to promising East African Scientists interested in building career in clinical trial capacities in the area of vaccinology. This programme known as International Masters in Vaccinology (IMVACC) comprises one year of on-line teaching of vaccinology followed by a 6 months to one year specialization internship in a vaccine-related activity (industry, basic or translational research, regulatory affairs, etc.) including the preparation of a master's thesis. Graduates will gain a broad knowledge of how vaccines are designed, developed, manufactured and implemented through public health programs. The programme will consist of 4 theoretical modules in the first year of study totaling 40 ECTS (1200 study hours) followed with a Master's thesis in the second year carrying 20 ECTS (600 study hours). Some examinations will be done online while others will be done during face to face sessions that will require the candidate to travel to Lausanne University. #### What will be supported?




The costs for the course including registration, tuition fees, round trip flights, meals and accommodation during face to face visits to Lausanne University will be covered by the collaboration.

Successful candidates will be required to meet any other costs including any additional learning materials not offered online such as books, etc and costs for visa processing.

#### Who should apply?

Applicants with one of the following academic qualification can apply:

- Master in sciences (MSc) or doctorate (PhD) in human or veterinary medicine, biology or pharmacy
- Master in theoretical or applied sciences (MSc) with experience in microbiology, immunology, epidemiology or biomedicine
- Bachelor in sciences (BSc) with at least three years of full-time professional experience in microbiology, immunology, epidemiology or biomedicine
